CERTIFICATE COURSE IN INVESTMENT MANAGEMENT

The Certificate Course in Investment Management (CCIM) was jointly developed by the UST Graduate School – Center for Continuing Professional Education and Development and RJSermonia Financial Consultants with the aim of providing participants with a comprehensive understanding of the theory and practice of Investment Management.

This program was developed due in large part to the need of individuals and institutions for investment advice and guidance from ethical, objective and highly-trained professionals. The course took shape against the backdrop of extreme volatility in the global financial markets due to various global events (Brexit, Frexit, Calexit, Trump, etc.). In addition, the relatively low-level of education in investment management in the Philippines has caused many retail and some institutional investors to become victims of financial scams. Thus, this program is being offered in keeping with the mission-vision and core values of the UST Center for Continuing Professional Education.

Overview

The Certificate Course in Investment Management (CCIM) is currently the only program in the Philippines designed for individuals seeking to achieve a high level of competency in investment management.

The CCIM is a transformative experience designed to fit the schedule of the participants. It is a unique program in which foundational financial theories are blended with real-life relevance – lectures are loaded with practical applications and examples appropriate for the Philippine market.

The course is offered over a 9-week period, including a review session on basic statistics/financial mathematics and finance/economics, designed especially for those who need a refresher and those without finance/business background.

At the end of the program, and in line with Outcomes Based Education (OBE), there will be a final investment project. The previous session participants organized an Investment Club.

During the program, participants will learn to:

- Develop investment portfolio strategies based on modern portfolio theory, which is the work horse framework for building asset allocations, and postmodern portfolio theory.
- Develop investment policy for individuals and institutions.
- ✓ Develop specific investment strategies based on the individuals/institutions' goals and objectives, time horizon, and risk appetite.
- ✓ Manage investment portfolios.
- ✓ Analyze portfolio performance.
- ✓ Analyze regulatory and ethical issues related to investment management.
- Participants who successfully complete the program may earn 3 cognate units in the Master in Business Administration (MBA) program of the UST Graduate School (subject to particular conditions).
