## **MECHANICS**

## **GENERAL PROVISIONS**

- 1. The competition is open to all graduate students of any Philippine University.
- 2. There will be two categories:
  - First Category: Coursework-related Research Papers (Independent Research, Graduate Research Seminar, Coursework Projects)
  - Second Category: Thesis/Dissertation-based Research Papers (Humanities, Business, Health & Natural Sciences, Social Science & Education)
- 3. All applicants must fill-out and submit the **Application Form** endorsed by either the Advisor/Program Head/Dean. In addition, a **Journal Paper** of the title entry must also be prepared and submitted. Deadline of submission is on **March 17, 2018**.
- 4. The journal paper should follow the format prescribed by national/international journal of your discipline.
- 5. A student can only submit **one (1) entry** relevant to the chosen category.
- 6. The research paper entry must be original and has not been previously published.
- 7. There should be a selection committee and selection will be based on quality, written technical content and presentation effectiveness of the paper entry. The **qualified paper presenters** will be announced on **March 24, 2018**.
- 9. Selected paper entries will be presented during the St. Antoninus of Florence Graduate Research Forum on **April 7, 2018** at the UST TARC Auditorium.
- 10. For the first category, only one winner will be declared. In the second category, winner will be selected for each cluster (Humanities, Business, Sciences, Social Science & Education).
- Winners of Best paper presentations will be announced during the closing ceremony on April 7, 2018. Each winner will receive cash prize of Php 5,000 and a St. Antoninus medallion.
