





The UST Graduate School shall implement the following learning delivery modalities beginning 2nd Term, AY 2022-2023:

ONSITE classes for the following courses:

- Laboratory courses
- Practicum courses (except for host training establishments offering online/remote work modalities)

HYBRID classes for all other courses wherein **LECTURE** sessions shall be conducted **ONLINE** while the following learning activities shall be administered face-to-face:

- Preliminary and/or Final Examination or its corresponding equivalent requirement
- Written/Practical Long Examination
- Submission of requirements
- Class consultations
- Class Research work /Library activities
- Select Individual/Group Reports

To facilitate physical distancing during face-to-face learning activities, the COHORTS* below shall be observed. Only students who are part of the scheduled cohort are allowed to enter the building.

NOTE: Prerequisite Philosophy and Foreign Language courses are under Cohort 2. PhD students belonging to Cohort 1 shall be required to attend onsite sessions of these classes in Cohort 2 should they enroll in any of these courses.

*shall be administered face-to-face irrespective of the assigned cohort

Other Reminders:

- COVID-19 vaccination is STRONGLY recommended however, is NOT required for face-to-face classes

- As ALL programs offered in the Graduate School are regular DEGREE programs and not Distance Learning programs, there is NO available option for FULL ONLINE learning.
- Graduate students and faculty members residing in distant provinces or abroad are advised to plan travel and living arrangements for the coming term in time for the start of their respective Cohort Schedule.
