- Certificate of Good Moral Character (from former school or current employer)
- Certificate of Employment (At least one (1) year of relevant clinical experience, either in the hospital or community setting)
- Copy of PRC license (Registered nurse with an updated PRC card)
- Nursing portfolio of professional experience and competencies
- For foreign applicants from EFL countries (English as a Foreign Language):
  TOEFL, IELTS or TOEIC ·
- Referral Form. This confidential form must be directly submitted to graduate-school.admission@ust.edu.ph by the recommender.
