- Certificate of General Weighted Average (GWA) or GPA (for non-UST Graduates only)
- Official and Original Transcript of Records (Graduate of a Bachelor of Science in Nursing from a HEI)
- Certificate of Good Moral Character (from former school or current employer)
- Certificate of Employment (At least one (1) year of relevant clinical experience, either in the hospital or community setting)
- Copy of PRC license (Registered nurse with an updated PRC card) Nursing portfolio of professional experience and competencies
- For foreign applicants from EFL countries (English as a Foreign Language): TOEFL, IELTS or TOEIC
- Referral Form
